Front Brake Line Mounting

Some front brake lines may have been mounted on the bottom side of the control arm as shown in figure 1. Please take a moment to check *both* front brake line routings and then refer to the drawings below:

The brake line routing should be mounted on the top side of the control arm as shown in figure 2. If your front brake lines are mounted as shown in figure 1 (on the bottom of the upper control arm), please remove the retaining bolt, rotate the brake line locating bracket as shown in figure two. Then place a small amount of blue Loctite on the bolt, replace it into the upper control arm and torque the bolt to 13.8 – 18.8 ft pounds
